GROW Library

GROW now has an online Library which will be a "One Stop Shop" for print and online resources.

The link to the Library is via this link, or via the GROW Website under the Programs Heading.

Accessible from any computer or mobile device, the GROW Library provides Two resource options for Students:

Option One:

GROW has a Book Library. This Library is focused on English Books that are required for students to complete their course (this is especially true for the Junior High Students who need a book to Read for their English Class).



The Book Library also has books that students may use for Free Reading.

Please use the Search Option (located at the top of the GROW Library website) to find your book. Once you find your book, please contact your teacher with the name of the book to reserve your choice (note that you may take out more than one book for an unlimited amount of time).

Option Two:

GROW has online resources available via the BC Digital Collection (all resources are online). As discussed in previous Weekly Newsletters, all students have access to this online library for resources that are available from Kindergarten to Grade 12. Given the GROW Library, these links are now available on this site so users can quickly access the links.
