What is a Substantive Assignment? Students must complete approximately 5% of their course before they are officially enrolled in GROW. What this means is that:

 For Grades K to 7 students are provide a package of materials that must be completed before they receive their

- coursework. The Substantive Assignment covers Art, Mathematics, English, Social Studies, Science, and Physical Education.
- For Grades 8 12, students must complete and successfully hand-in the First Unit of their course (First Learning Guide in Moodle).
