

## How Do I Download My Free Version of Office 365?

Every student gets a free version of Office 365 that they can install on five different devices that they own. To do this, login to Office 365 (Find It Fast at the top of the <a href="www.sd27.bc.ca">www.sd27.bc.ca</a> website), choose "Install Office" on the top right-hand corner and then "Office 365 Apps." Follow the prompts to download the free version of Office 365.
